# CROCHET FACE MASK

A guide on how to make crocheted face masks





These masks do not, in any way, serve as medical-grade protective equipment. They will not provide the necessary protection against virus, sickness, or disease.

They are mainly for aesthetic purposes.

Kindly use and produce at your own
discretion.

## MATERIALS

### **FOR PATTERN A:**

- 3.75mm crochet hook
- size 3 light worsted yarn

### **FOR PATTERN B:**

- 3.25mm crochet hook
- size 2 sock weight yarn

## CROCHET FACE MASK A

This fits small to medium face size when made with weight 3 yarn, and a 3.50mm to 3.75mm hook size. You may adjust the hook size as fits your preference and crochet style.

Using 8ply hand-dyed cotton (size 3), and a 3.75mm hook, the finished product measured 8 inches in length, and 4.75 inches in height.

The attached diagram pattern calls for the stitches to be done in back loop only. You may follow that for the "accordion" effect, or maintain the simple design by going through both loops.



## CROCHET FACE MASK A

MAIN BODY - START: CHAIN 38

#### ROW 1:

IN THE SECOND CHAIN FROM THE HOOK, , SC 6, HDC 3, DC 19, HDC 3, AND SC 6 (37 STITCHES)

#### ROW 2 TO 8:

CH 1, SC ON TOP OF EACH SC FROM BELOW (6), HDC ON TOP OF EACH HDC FROM BELOW (3), DC ON TOP OF EACH DC FROM BELOW (19, HDC ON TOP OF EACH HDC FROM BELOW (3), SC ON TOP OF EACH SC FROM BELOW (6) - 39 STITCHES

#### ROW 9:

CH 1, SC ON TOP OF EACH FROM BELOW (6), HDC ON TOP OF EACH HDC FROM BELOW (3), DC ON TOP OF 9 DC FROM BLOW (9), ON THE 10TH DC, DC 3 INTO THE SAME SPACE (3), DC ON TOP OF 9 DC FROM BLOW (9), HDC ON TOP OF EACH HDC FROM BELOW (3), SC ON TOP OF EACH SC FROM BELOW (6) - 39 STITCHES.


#### ROW 10:

CH 1, SC ON TOP OF EACH SC FROM BELOW (6), HDC ON TOP OF EACH HDC FROM BELOW (3), DC ON TOP OF EACH DC FROM BELOW (21), HDC ON TOP OF EACH HDC FROM BELOW (3), SC ON TOP OF EACH SC FROM BELOW (6) - 39 STITCHES

#### STRAP

FROM THE END OF THE BODY (TOP), CHAIN 35, THEN JOIN TO THE BOTTOM OF THE BODY WITH AN SC. SC 36 IN EACH OF THE STITCHES AT THE BOTTOM UNTIL YOU REACH THE END (TOTAL OF 37 SC PLUS THE REMAINING 36), CHAIN 35 TO CREATE THE OTHER STRAP, THE JOIN WITH AN SC TO THE TOP OF THE BODY. SC 38 IN EACH OF THE STITCHES AT THE TOP UNTIL YOU REACH THE END OF THE ROW WHERE THE FIRST STRAP ENDED (TOTAL OF 39 SC, THE FIRST SC PLUS THE REMAINING 38). SC AROUND IN EACH OF THE STITCHES (INTO THE 35 CHAINS, 37 SC, 35 CHAINS, AND 39 SC)

\*\* YOU MAY ADJUST THE CHAINS FOR THE STRAP LOOPS AS TO YOUR FACE SHAPE. THE STRAPS INDICATED IN THIS PATTERN ARE MERELY TRANSLATIONS FOR THE DIAGRAM PATTERN BELOW.



## CROCHET FACE MASK B

This fits medium to large face size when made with weight 2 yarn, and a 3.00mm to 3.25mm hooksize. You may adjust the hook as fits your preference and crochet style.

Using 6 ply hand-dyed cotton (size 2), and a 3.25mm hook, the finished product measured 9.25 inches in length, and 6 inches in height.

The attached diagram pattern calls for the stitches to be done in the back loop only. You may follow that for the "accordion" effect, or maintain the simple design by going through both loops.



## CROCHET FACE MASK B

#### MAIN BODY - START: CHAIN 46

#### ROW 1:

IN THE SECOND CHAIN FROM THE HOOK,, SC 8, HDC 3, DC 23, HDC 3, AND SC 8 (45 STITCHES)

#### ROW 2 TO 11:

CH 1, SC ON TOP OF EACH SC FROM BELOW (8), HDC ON TOP OF EACH HDC FROM BELOW (3), DC ON TOP OF EACH DC FROM BELOW (23), HDC ON TOP OF EACH HDC FROM BELOW (3), SC ON TOP OF EACH SC FROM BELOW (8) - 45 STITCHES

#### **ROW 12:**

CH 1, SC ON TOP OF EACH SC FROM BELOW (8), HDC ON TOP OF EACH HDC FROM BELOW (3), DC ON TOP OF 11 DC FROM BELOW (11), ON THE 12TH DC, DC 3 INTO THE SAME SPACE (3), DC ON TOP OF 11 DC FROM BELOW (11), HDC ON TOP OF EACH HDC FROM BELOW (3), SC ON TOP OF EACH SC FROM BELOW (8) - 47 STITCHES.

#### ROW 13 TO 14

CH 1,SC ON TOP OF EACH SC FROM BELOW (8), HDC ON TOP OF EACH HDC FROM BELOW (3), DC ON TOP OF EACH DC FROM BELOW (25), HDC ON TOP OF EACH HDC FROM BELOW (3), SC ON TOP OF EACH SC FROM BELOW (8) - 47 STITCHES.

THIS IS THE END OF THE MAIN BODY OF THE MASK. FROM HERE, YOU CAN OPT TO BIND OFF AND ATTACH
YOUR OWN STRAPS, OR PROCEED WITHT HE CROCHETED STRAPS.

#### <u>STRAP</u>

FROM THE END OF THE BODY (TOP), CHAIN 40, THEN JOIN TO THE BOTTOM OF THE BODY WITH AN SC. SC 44 IN EACH OF THE STITCHES AT THE BOTTOM UNTIL YOU REACH THE END (TOTAL OF 45 SC, THE FIRST S PLUS THE REMAINING 44), CHAIN 40 TO CREATE THE OTHER STRAP, THEN JOIN WITH AN SC TO THE TOP OF THE BODY. SC 46 IN EACH OF THE STITCHES AT THE TOP UNTIL YOU REACH THE END OF THE ROW WHERE THE FIRST STRAP ENDED (TOTAL OF 47 SC, THE FIRST SC PLUS THE REMAINING 46). SC AROUND IN EACH OF THE STITCHES (INTO THE 40 CHAINS, 45 SC, 40 CHAINS, AND 47 SC).
